Backstory

Personality Traits

Jasmine is truly caring; she is very observant and conscientious of others' feelings. She is self-respecting, with personal integrity and underlying wisdom. However, she is a wallflower, with a fear of intimacy. She is vulnerable and stuck. She has difficulty expressing herself, and difficulty sharing her feelings with others, except with Dustin, her best friend. She is a sweet soul who has been hurt.

Development

As the story progresses, Jasmine vacillates between helplessness at events unfolding around her, and a new drive to take more control of her life. She starts out cautiously focused on her private little world, but has a growing desire to extend herself. As she witnesses the events around her, she develops the courage to express herself, which manifests itself as a wisdom that she is able to share with others, especially Antonio. She is also able to realize how she herself is growing, and opens herself up to trust and love Antonio.
